Saint John of God Hospital Clg is a subsidiary of Saint John of God Hospitaller Group and is a not-for-profit registered charity that provides high quality mental health and dementia care along with advanced wellbeing and education programmes through its three services: Saint John of God Hospital, Saint Joseph's and Mental Health First Aid Ireland.

Saint John of God Hospital, Stillorgan, Co. Dublin is an independent acute psychiatric teaching hospital with 180 inpatient beds and is one of the leading European providers in mental health treatment and care. The Hospital provides specialist inpatient services in Addictions, Psychosis, Eating Disorders, Psychiatry of Later Life and Adolescent Mental Health services and an extensive range of outpatient services.

A university teaching hospital, Saint John of God Hospital is affiliated with University College Dublin, Trinity College Dublin, Dublin City University, the University of Limerick, The Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland and the College of Psychiatrists of Ireland for undergraduate and postgraduate healthcare professional programmes.

Saint Joseph's, Shankill, is the largest care home in Ireland solely dedicated to dementia care and leads the way in dementia care in Ireland through innovation, education, and community engagement. Saint Joseph's provides residential care to 61 people and also provides day care and respite services. Saint Joseph's model of care is based on an internationally established format and is a Meaningful Care Matters Butterfly Home, offering specialised person-centred dementia care to people living with dementia, which focuses on not just people's physical and clinical needs but their emotional, psychological, social and spiritual needs too.

Mental Health First Aid Ireland: The hospital is licensed by Mental Health First Aid International to deliver Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) training across the Republic of Ireland and has provided training to over 17,000 people as Mental Health First Aiders. MHFA is the initial help given to someone who is developing a mental health problem, a reoccurrence of an existing mental health problem or someone who is in a mental health crisis. The first aid is given until appropriate professional support is received or until the crisis resolves.

Saint John of God Hospital Clg is a company limited by guarantee, not having a share capital. It is registered with the Companies Registration Office (No. 430743), the Charities Regulator (No. 20069858) and with Revenue (CHY No. 18282).
